Returning to my career in YOUR congregation is giving me such great pleasure. Since my very first interview with your search committee, I felt the warmth you have as a community for each other and the respect you have for the importance of maintaining your traditions and heritage. Having served in smaller congregations in the past I know how each of you values the importance of supporting the community. You all know that if you do not support your community no one else will. From the leadership of your congregation, to the committees all the way to the students who teach in your religious school—you clearly have a great deal of passion and commitment to ensuring the success of Beth El Congregation.
